







## Did You Know?

All Texas pool and spa service technicians must have a Residential Appliance Installer License (RAIL)

## What is a RAIL License?

A license for a residential appliance installer to perform electrical work that is limited to pool-related electrical installation and maintenance, on behalf of a residential appliance installation contractor.

## Who Must be Licensed?

Anyone who performs electrical work on a pool, including pumps, lights, blowers, heaters, control systems, etc.

What if I Work on a Pool or Spa without a RAIL License?

You are out of compliance with the State of Texas and subject to fines starting at \$2,000 and additional penalties.
